

BOARD MINUTES
JUNE 13, 2022

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, June 13, 2022 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Nikki Talbert, County Auditor Designee. Christy Bates was absent.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the agenda. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:31 a.m. - Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the minutes of June 6, 2022 as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m.. - Met with Andy McGuire, Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. Items discussed were: Troy Denny finished up demolition of old county building; ideas to rectify pot holes at sanitation center; pavement grinding is near completion to be followed up with crack sealer; road determination of pavement markings and coordinating pavement patching locations. Detour of Hwy 178 was discussed, as well as bridges throughout the county.

9:00 a.m..- Approval of quarterly interfund operating transfer from Rural Basic Fund (0011) \$429,250, General Basic Fund (0001) \$30,500 & LOST fund (0030) \$50,000 to Secondary Roads Fund (0020) totaling \$509,750 was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the interfund transfer as submitted. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:05 a.m..-Various Board and Committee report was held. Deke Wood attended a monthly RUSS meeting. Fred Snakenberg participated in Decat, SEIL and Judicial 8 meetings. Mike Hadley attended the Rural Housing Trust Fund meeting.

9:10 a.m..-Discussion of old/new business and public comment was not held due to no further topics to discuss.

9:15 a.m. – Official Canvass of June 7, 2022 Keokuk County Primary Election was held. LuAnn Berger entered with election canvass documents. Those present canvassed the election, noting a change regarding two write-in votes for Tom Greene on a Democrat ballot for the Board of Supervisor race. The equipment counts each write-in, although the precinct election officials may only count as one vote instead of two when a name is duplicated on a race on a ballot. Records reflect said matter.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 10:25 a.m.

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors adjourned to meet June 20, 2022.
