

BOARD MINUTES
JUNE 27, 2022

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, June 27, 2022 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg and Christy Bates, County Auditor. Daryl Wood was absent.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Mike Hadley to approve the agenda. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. RD Keep and Sean Strohmayer, News-Review was present.

8:31 a.m. - Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the minutes of June 20, 2022 as submitted. Mike Hadley seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m.- Meeting with Andy McGuire, Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department was not held.

9:00 a.m. – Review and approval of June 20, 2022 claim listing was held. Motion was made by Mike Hadley to approve the claim listing as submitted. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:05 a.m. – Approval of FY2022 appropriations resolution was held. Interdepartmental appropriations will be made to cover the DHS/EOC air conditioning and Courthouse HVAC upgrade expenses to date. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the resolution as submitted. Mike Hadley seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:10 a.m. -Approval of FY2023 departmental appropriations resolution was held. These amounts were Board approved during the budget adoption process in March. Motion was made by Mike Hadley to approve the resolution as submitted. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:15 a.m.-Consideration and possible approval of personnel report for Jessica Buehneman, part-time Recording Clerk, Recorder's Office was held with Dawn Goldman, Recorder. Date of hire - July 5, 2022, hourly rate of pay -- \$12 and scheduled twenty (20) hour work week. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the personnel report as submitted. Mike Hadley seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:20 a.m.- Approval of personnel report regarding resignation of Todd Evans, part-time Deputy, Sheriff's Office was held. Motion was made by Mike Hadley to approve the personnel report as submitted. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:25 a.m.- Various Board and Committee reports was held. Fred Snakenberg participated in an Early Childhood meeting. Mike Hadley attended a Department Head meeting and Rural Housing Trust Fund and Area 15 financial meetings.

9:30 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. The Board received a letter from the Mahaska Board of Supervisors objecting to construction of a carbon dioxide pipeline proposed by the Navigator Heartland Greenway LLC in order to protect the safety and prosperity of Iowans.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:35 a.m.
