8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by <u>Deke Wood</u> to approve the agenda. <u>Fred Snakenberg</u> seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

8:55 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. The HVAC walk-through for interested bidders is Wednesday, August 3, 2022, with opening of bids to follow on Wednesday, August 17, 2022. The opioid settlement, county payment and possible funding for addiction prevention and treatment was discussed. Drew Sanders, Assessor, entered to inform he ran the preliminary figures on residential values last Friday to find a possible 15% increase to assessed values that is directly based on current sales. This is of no surprise due to nontypical high-priced sales of homes recently. Drew will report on the other property value assessments once completed.
