Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of quarterly interfund operating transfer from Rural Services Fund of \$430,500 and LOST fund of \$80,750 to the Secondary Roads Funds as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports was held. Snakenberg participated in a Decat meeting. Hadley met to attend to Rural Housing Trust Fund financial matters. Wood had no meetings last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. The Kiwanis provided a pavilion progress update by email. Bates informed of the following election matters: October 13th - public test; October 19th - first day to vote in office and mail ballots and October 25th - precinct election training.
