The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, October 24, 2022 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood, Christy Bates, County Auditor and Paula Rasplicka, Auditor's Designee.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of October 17, 2022 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department as follows: crews are ditching, completed mowing of paved roads, mowing gravel roads for the third time, blading and prepping for winter. Blading through dust control areas may begin November 1, 2022. Discussion arose regarding blading through calcium chloride dust control throughout the season due to moisture rejuvenation and to help eliminate pot holes. McGuire is to meet with a Miller-Meeks staffer regarding V5G that was selected as a project earlier this year.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of personnel report for retirement of Mary Sue Votroubek (full time) Administrative Assistant – County Attorney as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports was held. Snakenberg attended Early Childhood and SADC meetings. Hadley attended Semco and Keokuk County department head meetings. Wood attended no meetings last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Bates informed of the upcoming Conservation department budget amendment timeline due to marsh project grant reimbursement.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:30 a.m.
