The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, November 14, 2022 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of October 3, 2022 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. Last week, motor grader training and operation, flagger training, quarry and mining safety and chainsaw operation and maintenance, as well as the annual safety meeting last Thursday; and continue to work on preparation for snow removal. Discussion arose regarding current contact with Don Burdock regarding extension of a field entrance. Board consensus was no recollection of said claim or agreement thereof.

Met with Michelle Herman, Veterans Affairs/General Assistance Coordinator, regarding the General Assistance budget and funding increase to the rent, utilities and funeral line items. Board consensus was to allow said request, although bump the amount up to \$20,000 due to anticipated requests for assistance instead.

Various board and committee reports was held. Wood attended Pathfinders and RUSS meetings. Snakenberg participated in Mental Health and SEIL meetings. Hadley had no scheduled meetings to attend last week.

Public hearing regarding proposed Fiscal Year 2022 Keokuk County Budget amendment and possible approval of budget appropriations resolution thereof was held. The Conservation amendment is a pass-through Fish Habitat grant for \$220,000 and the Elections amendment is carrying forward unused FY22 HAVA Cybersecurity grant expenditure of \$10,000 into the FY23 budget. No oral or written comments were received. Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to close the public hearing at 9:32 a.m. All ayes and motion carried. Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve the FY2022 amendment and appropriations resolution as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. The Kiwanis provided a pavilion progress update for review. ISG provided a county inspection update was provided for review as well.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:45 a.m.
