8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by <u>Deke Wood</u> to approve the agenda. <u>Fred</u> <u>Snakenberg</u> seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was RD Keep, The News-Review.

8:31 a.m.- Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by <u>Fred Snakenberg</u> to approve the minutes of January 24, 2022 as submitted. <u>Deke Wood</u> seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:30 a.m. - Met with Engineer Andy McGuire regarding Keokuk County Highway Department.

1. Review and possible approval on a proposal for replacement of excavator was held. Andy informed he has been in negotiations with the Caterpillar salesman regarding a 320-07GC (20 ton) track hoe that includes: a thumb; additional safety cameras and 72-month warranty/5500 hours at the cost of \$217,000 outright, that would replace the 318C (18 ton) with 12,000 hours. Motion was made by <u>Deke Wood</u> to approve the 320-07GC CAT excavator track hoe purchase at the cost of \$217,000 as submitted. <u>Fred Snakenberg</u> seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Board consensus was to retain the 318C for brush cutting following thoughtful discussion thereof.

9:30 a.m. – Various board and committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended Belva Deer Inn meeting as Pathfinders/Pathways representative, 1015 Transit and Assessor's Conference Board meeting.
