## KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS FEBRUARY 28, 2022

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Tuesday, February 28, 2022 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was RD Keep, News Review.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of February 22, 2022 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding Keokuk County Highway Department. Old county shop demo bids are due Wednesday, March 2, 2022. Andy informed he will have a student with him next Monday that will be job shadowing for the day. Discussion arose regarding FY23 Secondary Roads funding sources and uncertainty of formula disbursement allocations thereof.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended 1015 Transit and annual Belva Deer Inn Stockholders (as Pathfinders rep.) meetings. Hadley attended Area 15 and Board of Health meetings. Snakenberg had no meetings to attend last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Don Arduser requested for the FY23 recycling center mowing rate to be raised to \$60 per service due to increased gas prices. Board consensus was to approve said request. The FY23 Keokuk County budget was reviewed.

Public hearing regarding proposed maximum property tax dollars for fiscal year 2023 was held. The Board reviewed the proposed tax levy, noting the supplemental had since been reduced by .20. No oral or written objections were received. Deke Wood moved, Fred Snakenberg seconded to close the public hearing. All ayes and hearing closed at 9:37 a.m.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of fiscal year 2023 maximum property tax dollars resolution as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to set the FY23 Keokuk County budget public hearing for March 14, 2022 at 9:30 a.m. in the Keokuk County Courthouse Boardroom 1<sup>st</sup> floor. All ayes and motion carried.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:45 a.m.
