The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, August 29, 2022 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the agenda. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

8:31 a.m. - Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the minutes of August 22, 2022 as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m. - Approval of 28D Agreement between Mahaska County Board of Health and Keokuk County Board of Health was held. Eric Dursky is employed to perform sanitarian duties involving septic systems and wells for the Keokuk County Board of Health. This is a continuance of the existing 28D for the next two years. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the 28D Agreement as submitted. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:00 a.m.- Possible approval of personnel report for hire of Devan S. Fraise, Sheriff's Office, part-time jailer/dispatcher was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the personnel report as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:05 a.m. – Various board and committee reports was held. Deke Wood attended a 1015 Transit meeting. Mike Hadley attended Board of Health, Area 15, Iowa State Association of Counties (ISAC) and Department of Transportation Service Agency Board meetings. Fred Snakenberg had no scheduled meetings last week.

9:10 a.m. – Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Michael Berg entered to discuss continued service on the English River Watershed Board. Board consensus was to confirm by official action following receipt of paperwork from Jody Bailey, English River Watershed Project Coordinator. Jeff Kiebel, Custodian, was present to discuss receipt of water conditioner bids that will be placed on next week's agenda for formal action. Jeff reminded the light bar still needs to be installed on the JD Gator to help with upcoming snow removal. Kevin Kurka, Design Engineers, sent notice to watch for the AIA owner/contract agreement to be received by mail this week. Christine Edmundson Long, Treasurer, provided replacement claim and Local Option Sales Tax (LOST) estimated payments for FY2023.
