The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, December 19, 2022 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

Wood moved, Hadley seconded to approve the minutes of December 12, 2022 as submitted. Motion carried. Snakenberg abstained due to being absent from said meeting.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. Andy discussed the all systems over weight permit passed by the legislature, that was initiated from industries, is not valid on the interstate system. Also mentioned was if a county chooses to “opts in”, specific routes do not have to be designated.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of Keokuk County Official Holiday resolution for calendar year 2023 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports was held. Wood attended the Compensation Board, RUSS, 1015 Transit and Crime Commission meetings. Snakenberg participated in Mental Health, SEIL and Judicial Eight meetings. Hadley attended Compensation Board, Emergency Management and DOT Freight Council meetings last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Enrollment forms for the Delta Vision Plan for FY24 have been submitted. A termination letter has been sent to Avesis as well.
